Maria was born on the farm 2 miles north of Fredonia on 6-26-1888. She married Salomon Mueller on 6-6-1908 at Fredonia N. D. They farmed north of Fredonia until 2-08-1915 when they moved to Gackle. Salomon had taken a job working on the dray line, for Henry Jenner. In 1916 Salomon bought the dray line. A few years later he was appointed Gackle City Marshall. In 1942 he was elected Logan County sheriff and in 1943 they moved to Napoleon N. D. to take office. They lived there until their deaths. Salomon died on 10-22-1953 & Maria died on 6-15-1962

3. Johan (John). Born in Russia 9-24-1886 Died 3-15-1887 in Tripp Dakota Territory (South Dakota). Buried at Emmanuel Lutheran Cemetery

4. Art Born on the farm north of Fredonia on 11-7-1899, died at age 2 on 7-13-1902 of diphtheria, buried in the Lutheran Cemetery $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to the east of the farm on Hwy 53, 3 miles north of Fredonia. Art & John, # 5 share a headstone, they are buried head to head.

5. John, Born on the farm north of Fredonia on 7-9-1895, died at age of 7 on 7-16-1902 of diphtheria, buried in the Lutheran Cemetery with # 4 Art above
